1. Woodredding Farm (GR SO640298) (///anthems.basher.hairstyle)

10.30am – 5pm. Low volume, award-winning maker of cider and perry made in the traditional way relying on wild yeast. See how a small-scale cider maker can use both old and new technology and learn how to make their own cider. Enjoy baps with sausages made with our own cider.

2. Lyne Down Organics (GR SO646312) (HR8 2NT) (///vented.overhaul.redeeming)

10am – 6pm -Visit our traditional organic orchard. Watch the pressing or take the opportunity for a hands-on experience to 'pick and press' cider apples. Meet our Ryeland 'Teddy Bear' sheep and donkeys. Tastings and sales of apple juice, cider, perry, honey and homemade jams. Bring a picnic and enjoy the views.

3. Avenue Cottage (GR SO649321) (HR8 2NU) (///remarking.device.heats)

11am – 5pm. Cottage perrymaking, fruit pressing, single variety perry for sale. An abundance of fruit and nut trees and hedges of edible berries in our replanted orchards. Bring a picnic to our meadow overlooking the panoramic view to the Malvern Hills and beyond. Apple refreshments and all donations in aid of 1st Much Marcle Guides.

4. Westons Cider (GR SO649331)(HR8 2NQ) (///strapped.hacksaw.kidney)

10am to 5pm. Shop and Scrumpy House Restaurant open with special site-only offers. Play area open. Westons are Platinum Corporate Members of Herefordshire Wildlife Trust. The Trust will be present and a 'Westons Wildlife Walk', created in association with them, is available to download <https://www.westons-cider.co.uk/visit/local-walks>

5. Much Marcle Memorial Hall (GR SO658330) (///engine.quietly.soggy)

11am – 5.30pm Serving apple teas and soup and roll lunches, plus produce stall.

6. St Bartholomew's Church (GR SO657327) (///blaze.develops.masts)

10.30am – 5pm Church open for visitors all weekend.

7. Hellens (GR SO661332) (///copies.quote.regularly)

11am – 5pm A Feast of Apples – displays and tastings of many apple varieties, Hartpury Orchard Centre display of perry pears and perry sales, Dragon Orchard – sales of less usual varieties of apples, Jus single variety apple juice, Big Apple's own displays of apple varieties, Tools for Self Reliance Cymru, Herefordshire Beekeepers, MrPsBees traditional pruning services. Explore the gardens, house tours (advance booking) and refreshments available.

8. Awnells Farm (GR SO658319) (HR8 2NW) (///fork.overheard.hardly)

10.30am – 5pm Walk through the ancient cider and perry pear orchards plus nature scavenger hunt for families. Meet our traditional Hereford cattle, together with more recent arrivals Golden Guernsey goats, Shetland sheep and a Shetland pony. Display of working stationary engines, vintage carts and vehicles and old farm tools. Explore the Midlands Air Ambulance Charity helipod. Refreshments available.

9. Gregg's Pit (GR SO662323) (HR8 2NL) (///plotting.mainframe.twinge)

10.30am – 6pm Craft cider and perry making in a traditional orchard. Meet the makers, their standard trees and vintage fruit, watch the pressing, taste and buy sparkling/draught cider and perry. Ploughman's lunches by Truffles Delicatessen.

Grid references are accurate to 100m. Postcodes are provided where navigation apps will take you near to the venue – typically within 200m. We have omitted postcodes where they do not take you close to the venue or provide misleading directions.
